


Trilium grandiflorum - Leaf templates



Align the 3 parallel lines with the paper's grain when cutting.

Use a dark/lighter green doublet paper, darker side is the top surface (towards the sky), lighter is the underside (towards the ground). You can purchase doublet paper, or make your own by;

- Fusing paper together with very lightweight fusible web, that is ironed between two pieces of paper, or
- Laminating two pieces of paper together with glue.

Making your own double-sided paper gives you more options for color combinations. Ensure paper is joined out to the edge and grain is oriented the same direction for both pieces of paper.
