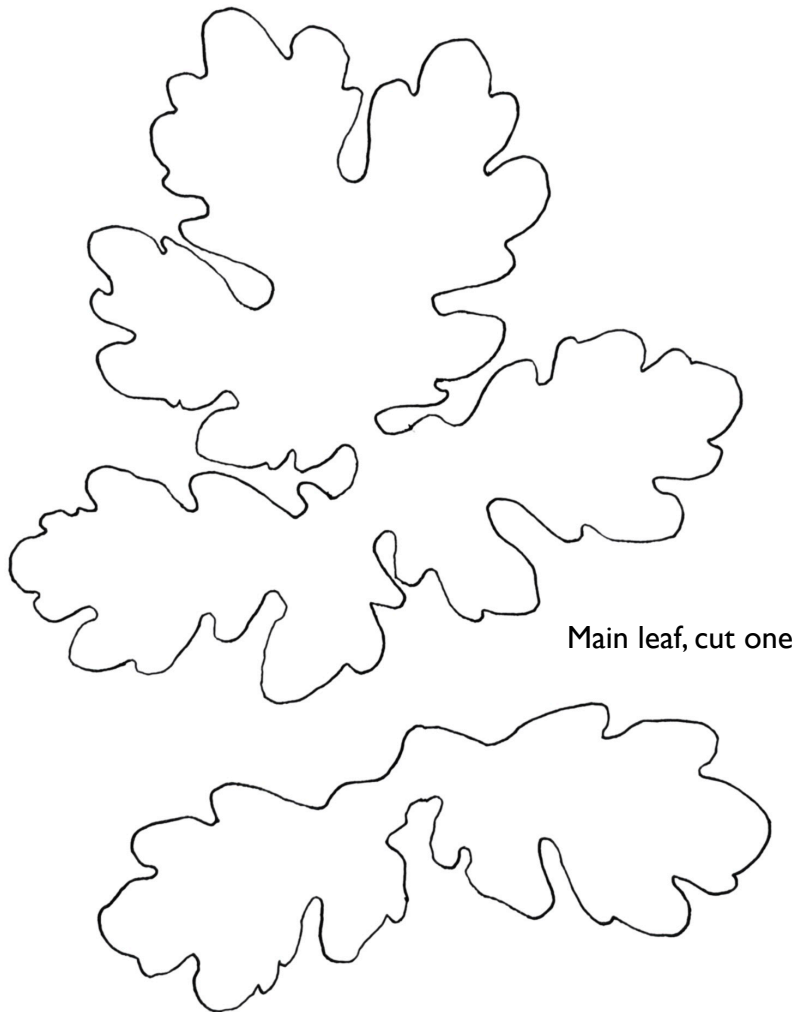
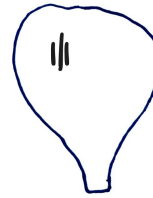


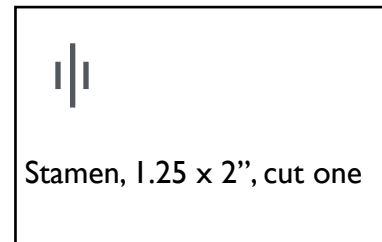
# Templates & Family Tree



Main leaf, cut one



Petals, cut 4. Use similar shape for small leaves, cut 2



Stamen, 1.25 x 2", cut one



Specialized leaves covering seed pod, cut 4, size according to pod size

*Clade* ANGIOSPERMS  
*Order* RANUNCULALES  
*Family* PAPAVERACEAE  
*Genus* STYLOPHORUM  
*Species* DIPHYLLUM

Celandine Poppy, Wood Poppy, Yellow Wood Poppy

Other than the main leaf, this bloom is made from simple shapes which can be cut without a template.

The genus name describes the form of the female structure; *stylos* translates to 'style' and *phoros* describes its long, knobby form. These smaller leaves are described in the species name, *di* means 'two' and *phyllum* is 'leaf'. Diphylum = two leaves.

This plant's name describes its appearance: "Knobby style, two leaves" which distinguishes it from other members of the Poppy family.
